

# MW1000 Suspended Cradle Installer/Operator



## Course Aim

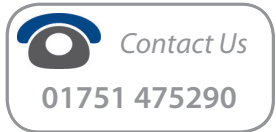
To provide information relating to installation, examination, operation and dismantling of the MW1000 suspended access system on a Vestas V90 wind turbine.

## Course Duration

2 Days

**Day 1** - Classroom based theory and assembly and inspection of the MW1000.

**Day 2** - (a) Practical demonstration, installation, examination and operation of the MW1000 on a Vestas V90 wind turbine. (b) Practical and written assessment and course summary.



## Learning Outcomes

- Identify parts of a temporary suspended access system, including safety equipment and systems.
- State the hazards, considerations and legislation associated with the use of temporary suspended access equipment.
- Describe duties and responsibilities and attributes of a temporary suspended access systems installer and operator.
- Assemble, operate and dismantle the MW1000 access system in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.
- Describe the procedure for Thorough Examination/Inspection of the MW1000 access system and complete a Thorough Examination.
- Describe the various types of inspection and explain when they are necessary and who is responsible for completing them.
- Carry out emergency procedures and use emergency equipment safely and effectively.

## Scope

Delegates will be trained to install and operate the MW1000 temporary suspended access equipment on a Vestas V90 only. A certificate of training will be issued to successful delegates on completion of the course. The certificate is valid for 2 years. Instructor : delegate ratio Onshore 1 : 6 - Offshore 1 : 4

## Location / Requirements

The instructor will travel to the customer's site to deliver the training. A suitable meeting/training room with mains power and space to set up a projector is required. A current report of thorough examination as required by LOLER '98 must be available for any suspended access equipment designated for use during training.

*The instructor has the right to exclude any trainee from training at any stage if they have concerns regarding the trainee's health and/or fitness or regarding the trainee's attitude with regard to maintaining safety during training.*
